Domestic Violence Services

Did you know that Catholic Charities runs the First Step Victim Services program? This initiative assists any innocent crime victim in Chemung and Schuyler County, with a particular emphasis on supporting victims of domestic violence. Our program provides various services, including safety planning, assistance with protection orders, court accompaniment, one-on-one counseling, advocacy, support, and much more. Additionally, we operate a 24-hour hotline staffed by our dedicated team.

While domestic violence often manifests as physical abuse, it can also involve other forms of violence, such as emotional, financial, sexual, and psychological abuse.

It's important to recognize that anyone can become a victim of domestic violence, regardless of age, race, gender, sexual orientation, faith, or socioeconomic status.

Housing Counseling

Catholic Charities of Chemung/Schuyler offers three key housing counseling services:

- **First Time Homebuyer's Program**: Celebrating 30 years in November 2024, it has helped 488 families purchase their first homes in Elmira, providing \$20,000 in closing cost/down payment assistance.
- **Mortgage Foreclosure Prevention Counseling**: Assists homeowners at risk of foreclosure in Chemung, Schuyler, Tompkins, and Tioga Counties through HUD Certified Housing Counselors.
- **Financial Fitness Counseling**: Personalized support for financial goals, including budgeting and credit improvement, available in the same counties and integrated with other programs.
